First Aid

Level 3 Award Emergency First Aid At Work (RQF)

Where an organisations First Aid Risk assessment highlights the need for Emergency First aiders, then this qualification will provide you with suitable, trained personnel.

This course will give the participants a qualification to the level of Emergency First Aid, meeting the statutory requirements of the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981.

Mandatory Unit

- Unit 1 Emergency First Aid in the workplace.

Duration

A minimum of 6 hours tutor contact, consisting of practical and theoretical activities.

How is the qualification assessed?

The tutor will carry out ongoing assessment throughout the course.

A Three-year Level 3 award will be issued subject to successful completion and assessment.

Syllabus

A range of subjects are covered including: -

- Responsibilities and reporting
- Resuscitation and AED awareness
- Dealing with an unresponsive casualty
- Shock (including Anaphylaxis)
- Basic Hygiene in 1st Aid
- Choking
- Control of bleeding
- Minor Injuries
- Anatomy
- Burns
- Epilepsy
- Assessment of the situation

Numbers

Due to the practical nature of this course, a minimum of 4 candidates are required with a maximum of 12 candidates.

Minimum age of 14 years, although a student cannot assume responsibility for first aid until they attain the age of 16 years
